

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE HANCOCK COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE TO PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES TO THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, State of Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Hancock County Sheriffs Office to provide law enforcement services to the village.

SECTION 2: A copy of said contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into such agreement immediately in order that said enforcement may resume within the village.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
