

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON, OHIO TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTIVE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Arlington is planning to make capital improvements known as the Brine Backwash Water Diversion Project, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington:


Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described herein.

Section 2: The Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.


Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize submission of said application(s) in order to meet funding request deadlines.
