

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2010

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TAKE BIDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto:

SECTION 1: That a certain 1970 GM 6-cylinder engine and 4-speed transmission with unknown hours or miles is no longer needed in service and that same no longer serves any legitimate municipal purpose.

SECTION 2: That the value of said property is less than One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$ 1000.00) and may be sold to the highest bidder without formal advertisement pursuant to §721.15.


Section 3: That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to take bids for said property and to sell same to the highest bidder.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Arlington, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order that said useless property may be sold and the value of same received by the village.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
